He served as Coal Valley Township Supervisor and on the Rock Island County Board, and was a member of St. Maria Goretti Catholic Church, Coal Valley. He helped restore and bring a WW II Landing Ship Tank (<u>LST 325</u>) back to the U.S. in 2000.
